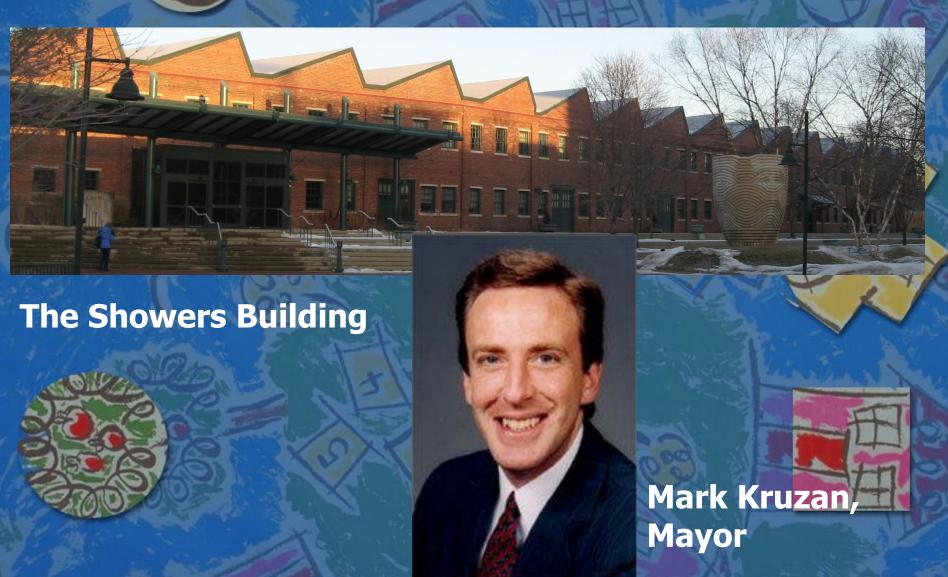

 Our library is run by the county (Monroe) rather than the city









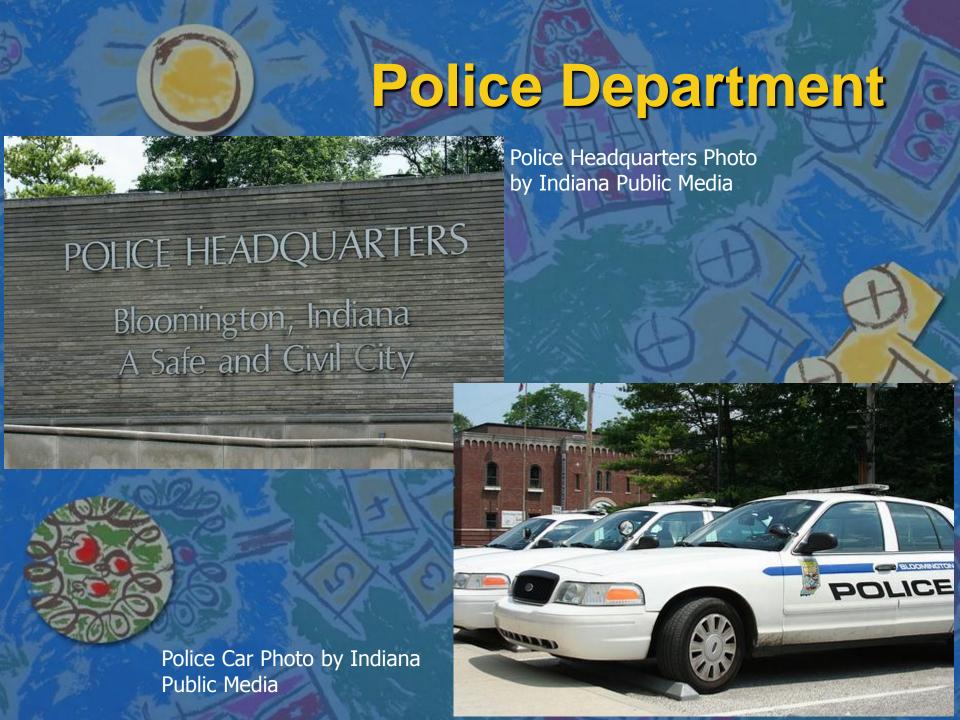
